

ERGO BARS FOR 2013 AND OLDER FLH

INCLUDED IN BOX:

Ergo Handlebars Instruction Sheet

NOTE:

Always refer to model appropriate service manual for procedures and torque specifications



Note: it is not necessary to change your clutch cable or brake line length. The routing will need to be changed to allow the maximum length allowable without binding in the steering head.

- 1. Protect painted surfaces
- 2. Remove the seat
- 3. Disconnect the negative battery cable
- 4. Remove windshield and outer fairing
- 5. Remove ignition switch knob and fairing cap (the piece with the "spot" and "accy" switches in it)
- 6. Remove radio
- 7. Locate and disconnect the right and left side handlebar switch connectors and disassemble the connectors
- 8. Remove grips, front brake and clutch controls from handlebar
- 9. Remove switch housing and wire assemblies from handlebar
- 10. Loosen, but do not remove the passing lamp bar fasteners, or turn signal mounts for FLHX, to allow access to handlebar fasteners
- 11. Remove all four handlebar clamp fasteners and carefully remove handlebar from risers
- 12. Install your new Ergo handlebars into the handlebar clamp, set the angle and torque to specification
- 13. Guide the switch wires through the handlebar until the switch housing are fully seated
- 14. Reassemble the switch wiring connectors.
- **15.** Install brake and clutch controls and check to make sure the clutch cable and brake lines are not in a bind when turning the steering head to left and right lock.
- 16. Reinstall all other removed components and torque to specification
